Containers & Plastics

Caps & lids must be removed from all:

All milk containers (jugs, cartons & bags)

Refundable beverage containers

Glass bottles & jars

Metal food cans

Clean aluminum foil & plates

Plastic containers (caps off)

Expanded polystyrene

(ie. Styrofoam™)

Grocery & bread bags

Refundable Containers

Deliver to an Enviro Depot to receive the refund. Or place in Blue Bag #1 for recycling.

BLUE BAG #2

Paper Products

Newspapers & flyers

Boxboard & paper boxes

Office paper

Magazines & catalogues

Egg cartons

Books (hard covers removed)

Cardboard (small amounts)

Cardboard

Empty & Flatten to save dumpster space or bundle for curbside collection.

ORGANICS GREEN CART

Compostables

Vegetables, fruit & peelings

Meat, fish & bones

Bread & pasta

Solid dairy products

Egg, fish & nut shells

Coffee filters & grinds

Tea bags

All leftover food (table scraps)

Soiled and non-recyclable paper, including:

Paper bags

Sugar & flour bags

Paper plates

Waxed paper

Paper fast food packaging (ie. Fry Boxes)

Restaurant pizza boxes

Soiled paper products

(ie. Napkins & Paper Towel)

GARBAGE BAG

Clear Bags

Hot & cold drink cups & straws

Soiled plastic wrap

Chip bags

Candy bar wrappers

Dirty aluminum foil

Netted bags

Frozen juice cans

Broken glass (wrapped for safety)

Incandescent light bulbs

Floor wweepings

Toilet paper

Personal hygiene products

Kitty litter

Diapers

Toys, dishes, fabric & shoes (consider reuse)

All small household appliances (ie. toaster)

**Sorting rules for Eastern Region Solid Waste Management are used in Potlotek*

Garbage: Picked up on Wednesdays - clear bags for garbage (with one grocery bag allowed inside for personal bathroom waste per week)

Recycling: Blue bags are picked up on Thursdays. Blue bag # 1 is for paper/cardboard and blue bag # 2 is for cans/bottles/plastics..
