AWARD

A scholarship of \$1,000 will be awarded to five members of the Unama'ki community.

OBJECTIVE

To promote and encourage education and careers in the field of Science and/or Technology within the Unama'ki Mi'kmaq Communities.

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a registered band member of the Unama'ki District;
- Currently enrolled in an accredited undergraduate or graduate level certificate, diploma and/or degree program in the following field of studies:
 - a) **Science** including Forestry, Biology, Chemistry, Earth Sciences, Integrated Sciences;
 - b) **Technology** including Environment, Engineering, Surveying/Mapping;
 - c) **Natural Resources**.
- Must be a full-time student and returning to school in the fall, or a current graduate from one of the above listed programs.

Applicants are asked to submit a **two-page double-spaced essay** emphasizing present and future contributions to science or technology within the Mi'kmaq community, an official **transcript of marks**, and a **letter of recommendation** from a professor or advisor.

Scholarships are awarded to undergraduate and graduate students based on leadership, academic achievement and community involvement.

The deadline for applications is **MONDAY August 1, 2022**
