AWARD

A Scholarship of \$5,000 will be awarded to a member of an Unama'ki community (Potlotek, Eskasoni, Membertou, Wagmatcook, and Waycobah).

OBJECTIVE

To promote and encourage education and careers in the Forestry Sector and related fields within the Unama'ki Mi'kmaw Communities

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a registered band member of the Unama'ki District
- Currently enrolled in an accredited undergraduate or graduate level certificate, diploma and/or degree program in a Forestry or Forestry-related field:
 - a) Science including Forestry, Biology, Earth Sciences, Integrated Sciences;
 - b) **Technology** including Environment, Engineering, Surveying/Mapping;
 - c) Natural Resources
- Must be a full-time student and returning to school in the fall, or a recent graduate from one of the above listed programs.

Applicants are asked to submit a **two-page double-spaced essay** emphasizing present and future contributions to science or technology within the Mi'kmaw community, an official **transcript of marks**, and 2 **letters of recommendations** one from a professor or advisor, one from community, demonstrating academic achievement., leadership and community involvement.

Scholarships are awarded based on leadership, academic achievement and community involvement.

The deadline for applications is **MONDAY August 1, 2022**
