AWARD

5,000 to be awarded to a member of the Unama'ki Communities.

OBJECTIVE

To promote and encourage education and careers in the Forestry Sector and related fields within the Unama'ki Mi'kmaw Communities

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a registered band member of the Unama'ki District
- Currently enrolled in an accredited undergraduate or graduate level certificate,
 - a) **Science** including Forestry, Biology, Earth Sciences, Integrated Sciences;
 - b) **Technology** including Environment, Engineering, Surveying/Mapping;
 - c) **Natural Resources**
- Must be a full-time student and returning to school in the fall, or a recent graduate from one of the above listed programs.

Applicants are asked to submit a **two-page double-spaced essay** emphasizing present and future contributions to science or technology within the Mi'kmaw community, **an official transcript of marks**, and **2 letters of recommendations** one from a professor or advisor, one from community, demonstrating academic achievement, leadership and community involvement.

Scholarships are awarded based on leadership, academic achievement and community involvement.
