AWARD

One scholarship of \$5000 will be awarded to an eligible Unama'ki community member.

OBJECTIVE

To encourage education and careers in the Forestry Sector and related fields within the Unama'ki Mi'kmaw Communities

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants:

- Must be a registered band member of the Unama'ki District.
- Either currently enrolled in, or a recent graduate of, an undergraduate or graduate level certificate, diploma and/or degree program in a Forestry or Forestry-related field:
 - **Science** including Forestry, Biology, Earth Sciences, Integrated Sciences
 - **Technology** including Environment, Engineering, Surveying/Mapping
 - **Natural Resources**

HOW TO APPLY

Applicants are asked to submit:

- A two-page double-spaced essay emphasizing present and future contributions to science or technology within the Mi'kmaw community.
- A transcript of marks from you college or university
- A letter of recommendation from a professor or advisor.
